

XPath Explorer is a simple utility that can be used to test XPath queries. With XPath Explorer you can learn how to use XPath, or simply refine your existing queries.

- Open XML documents by clicking the “Get XML Document” button, or by dragging an XML file on top of the application.
- The hierarchy of your XML document will be displayed in the top listbox.
 - You can view node attributes by double-clicking on a node.
- Relative XPath queries will be run from the node selected in your listbox. In the example picture below, I am using a relative query to select the items inside a selected SubHeading node.
- The XPath result, a node list, will be displayed in the bottom listbox.
